

In Memoriam: Father Len Cadieux

January 13, 1959 – January 9, 2026

Born in Edmonton on January 13, 1959, to Charles Cadieux and Denise Cadieux-Couturier, Fr. Len was formed at St. Joseph's Seminary and ordained to the priesthood on May 29, 1989, at St. Joseph's Basilica by the Most Rev. Joseph MacNeil.

Over more than three decades of priestly ministry, he served in parishes throughout the Archdiocese of Edmonton, including St. Joseph's Basilica (Associate Pastor and Rector), Assumption Parish (Edmonton), *St. Vital Parish (Beaumont)*, and St. Mary Parish (Red Deer), among others.

Fr. Len also served with distinction as a Canadian Forces Military Chaplain, attaining the rank of Lieutenant Commander / Major. His service included assignments with HMCS *Nonsuch*, the 41st Brigade Group, and deployment as a United Nations Peacekeeper Chaplain in the Golan Heights. In recognition of his service, he received the Alberta Centennial Medal in 2013.
